

WAYNE LION'S TRACK AND FIELD MEET

DATE: Wednesday, May 16, 2018

Grades K-6 (First year of meet: Spring 1988)

NEW THIS YEAR WILL BE A KINDERGARTEN DIVISION!!!!

The annual Wayne County Elementary Track Meet for grades K-6 is scheduled for WEDNESDAY, MAY 16TH. The purpose of the meet is twofold: **1. Find an evening that works best for elementary athletes to have a chance to experience track; 2. To recognize the State Qualifiers from the schools in Wayne County.** We plan to introduce all the state qualifiers from the three schools that evening prior to the start of the meet. There will be no pre-registration again this year. Just bring your entry form along with you that evening and we will heat and assign everything at that time. (*We printed the entry form on the back to save paper.*) Awards will be presented to both a girls and boys division in each grade. All participants will receive participation ribbons. You will not compete against athletes in another grade.

General Information

There will be a track meet for boys and girls in **Grades K-6** on Wednesday, May 16th, beginning at 5:00 p.m. The meet will be held at the Wayne High Track. If you are in kindergarten, first, or second grade, please report by 4:45 p.m. If you are in the third or fourth grade, please report by 5:30 p.m. All fifth and sixth graders should report by 6:00 p.m. Students will be competing with others in their grade. We will complete the field events of the K, 1st and 2nd graders. When their running events begin, we will start field events for 3rd and 4th, etc. K, 1st, and 2nd graders should be done and awards presented by 6:30. We anticipate that the meet will be over for all grades by 8:30. There will be a \$5.00 entry fee per contestant, which includes a sports drink. **If we have inclement weather, listen to KTCH radio for possible cancellations.**

Limit of Events

All athletes must limit themselves to three events. Once you enter events, you cannot change. The jumping and throwing events will occur first in each division. The running events will follow and be run during the field events of the next division.

Reporting Point and Registration

All athletes/parents should report to the table east of the track building to check in. At that time, you will be able to sign up for three events and pay your registration. We would also ask the parents to sign a waiver at that time. Each athlete will be given three stickers with their events on them. When the event is called they should report to the clerk of the start with their sticker for that event.

Use of the Track

Students are encouraged to use the track before the meet. The track is open to the public. We may have a few state qualifiers practicing, but feel free to come down anytime. Please leave all equipment as found, especially the high jump pits. Do not jump on them with the cover on, and please return the cover when finished.

Awards

The first eight places will receive ribbons for individual events. Awards will be presented at the completion of your grades division.

Concessions

There will be a concessions stand available: hotdogs, pizza, pop, Gatorade, candy, etc.
