Wayne Community Schools is in need of more substitute teachers. If you are interested in becoming a substitute teacher in Wayne, please see below:

Nebraska offers two types of substitute teacher certification, <u>State Substitute</u> <u>Teacher</u> and <u>Local Substitute Teacher</u>. Both certifications require fingerprint background clearance for candidates who have NOT been a resident of Nebraska for at least five years prior to application.

- 1. <u>State Substitute Teacher</u> A five-year State Substitute Teaching Permit allows you to teach any subject at any level for no more than 90 days in the same assignment, though you can teach an unlimited number of days per year. The requirements for a State Substitute Teacher are a bachelor's degree and completion of a teacher education program at an approved college or university. You also must meet the Human Relations Training requirement or provide proof of having met the requirement from experience.
- 2. Local Substitute Teacher The three-year Local Substitute Teaching Certificate authorizes you to teach for a total of 90 days in one school year. The license is requested by the superintendent of an employing school system and is only valid for schools in that system. To qualify, you need a minimum of 60 semester credit hours of college courses with at least one course in professional education. You also must meet the requirement for coursework or work experience in Human Relations Training.
