Dear Parents,

As you are all aware, we have decided to close school effective Wednesday, March 18 through Friday, April 3. Please understand the closure could extend beyond April 3, and make the necessary preparations.

Lunches will be available to all students each weekday from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., starting Wednesday March 18 at the Jr/Sr High School kitchen, the Wayne Early Learning Center (801 Providence Road), and at the Carroll Library. Lunches will be grab-n-go with a breakfast item for the next morning. The students may not eat the lunch at the distribution location. The weekly backpack program will also be available on Fridays at the food distribution sites during the distribution times of 11:00 - 1:00.

Learning materials will be available on-line and at the school offices. Each Friday, teachers will post new supplemental learning activities for the students. If students do not have access to the Internet, the packets will be available at each school office on Fridays. The packets will contain work for the next week. All of this work is supplemental and enrichment only. We will not grade this work or expect it to be returned, however we do encourage you to contact your students teacher with questions, and we encourage students to do so as well.

Teachers will correspond to emails and phone messages from 10:00 - 11:00 AM, and 1:00 - 2:00 PM each day. If you email a teacher, you should expect a return message within 24-48 business hours. If you would like a teacher to call you, send an email, or call the school office and the secretary will relay the message.

The high school office phone number (402-375-3150) will be a Family Resource Line. The purpose of this will be to help provide assistance, answer questions about school work, day care needs, food needs, and other needs families might have. Please do not hesitate to call this number to ask questions from 8:00 - 4:00 each school day.

This is a very unusual situation as you all know, and we are doing our best to try to meet the needs of our students and families. Please contact the school, if you have any questions or concerns.
